This intern roles are designed for students working towards a construction or engineering degree and are interested in gaining solid, hands-on industry experience in a variety of construction facets. The PM/Estimating role requires at least one summer to have already been spent working on a project in the field in the industry.

This selected **Field Interns** will spend the summer outside in the field on a project alongside a project supervisor. The size and scope of the project(s) will vary throughout the summer. Time will also be spent with the Surveyor to gain an understanding of the various projects Crooker completes. During the summer the selected candidate will learn the necessary components it takes to complete a project. These components will include, but may not be limited to; scheduling, working with the project manager to order materials, tracking employee's time, and understanding the associated paperwork for production and job site reports and billing. In order to gain experience, this will be a hands-on role, working alongside Crooker's field personnel learning the trade. Work will involve manual labor, surveying and layout, and possibly small equipment operation.

This selected **PM/Estimating Intern** will spend the summer in the office working alongside the estimating and project management team. The selected candidate will learn about estimating/bidding, project planning/scheduling, take-offs, layout, billing, and the general support needed to help projects run smoothly. During the internship the selected intern will learn how to utilize advanced technology such as GPS layout, autocad, AGTEK, etc. Time will also be spent with the Surveyor to gain an understanding of the various projects Crooker completes. During the summer time will also be spent with a Quality Control Technician and a Material Operations employee to learn the process of ensuring a high level of quality is being achieved producing and installing our materials.

- Must enjoy working in a team environment and be willing to assist other employees
